Using a Crisis Prevention Team to Assess, Educate and Retain Students

A review of a Crisis Prevention Team (CPT) that is utilized at a small university campus to identify, assess, and intervene when students are dealing with and recovering from self-harm threat, severe illness/injury, relationships, acting out behavior, grief and loss of family/friends, harassment, physical intimidation/assault, sexual assault, anger and alcohol and drug abuse. Analysis of the CPT will include make-up of the team (Dean of Students Office, Campus Police, Residence Life, Health Center, and Counseling), how the team assesses potential crisis and threats to campus, coordination and collaboration techniques used, and interventions directed at students in need of learning appropriate coping skills and behavior. Outcome and retention data will be provided.
